### **Luke 10:38-42 KJV**

38 "Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.

40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her."

- 3) How do you connect with God throughout the day?
- 4) What is our primary calling?
- 5) How does our primary calling sustain our secondary calling?
- 6) If a person does not desire to glorify God, how can this block them from hearing God?
- 7) If a person is filled with their own ideas and dreams of what ministry should look like to them and move in their own direction, how can this block them from hearing God?
- 8) If a person is not under the God sanctioned authorities in their life, how can this block them from hearing God?
- 9) Why is our one-on-one time with Jesus the most important time of our lives?
- 10) Is there anything in your life that you are doing that is NOT important and pulling you away from Jesus?
- 11) Is there anything that is good in your life that you have placed in competition with Jesus and pulling you away from Jesus?
- 12) What does it mean that who we are in Jesus is more important than what we do for Jesus?
- 13) Someone read Acts 4:12-13. What was the key to standing for God?
