God is **sovereign** - the supreme authority in all creation.  
(Isa 45:9-19, Rom 8:18-39, Jn 10:27-30)

God is **righteous** - perfect goodness.  
(Gen 18:25, Deut 32:4, Rom 1:16-17)

God is **just** - perfectly righteous in his treatment.  
(Job 34:12, Ps. 19:9, 67:4, 103:6, Isa 30:18)

God is **love**  
(Ps 145:9, Mark 10:18, 1 John 4:8, 16)

God is **eternal** - no beginning and no end.  
(Isa 9:6, Rom 16:26, Heb 9:14, 2 Pet 3:8)

God is **omniscience** - knows all past, present and future.  
(Ps 139:1-6, 13-16, 147:5, Isa 43:1-12, Acts 15:8)

God is **omnipotent** - all powerful.  
(Gen 1:1-3, 17:1, Isa 40:15, 27-31 Heb 1:3)

God is **omnipresent** - everywhere at all times.  
(Ps 139:7-12, Matt 6:1-8)

God is **immutable** - never changes.  
(Heb 1:12, 13:8, Mal 3:6)

God is **veracity** - perfect truth.  
(John 3:33, 14:6)

5. How are both God's justice and righteousness seen in the cross?
6. Many ask “If God is just, why is there so much injustice in the world?” Read 2 Peter 3:9 - How would you respond to this question?
7. Take any one of the aspects of God's nature we discussed, How does it help to know this about God when a crisis occurs?
